Scholarship update: Seniors, don't forget to check out available scholarships on the school website's lower right hand "Scholarships" tab. New this week is a CSEA scholarship which is due March 10th and one for the Savannah College of Art and Design.

Boys State: Attention all 11th grade boys interested in representing Saugus at the American Legion Boys State 2017! There will be an informational meeting on Friday, February 24th at lunch in room Q-1701. Boys State is the premiere leadership and citizenship program for young men in the country. Come to this meeting to find out how you can attend.

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) will be offered at Saugus on March 2nd at 1 PM. The ASVAB is a free test open to students in grades 10 through 12. The ASVAB is a career exploration test which provides students with information to learn more about career exploration and planning, in both the civilian and military worlds of work. To register for this free career interest test, please come to the counseling office. March 2nd is a district-wide minimum day, so you will not be missing any instructional time by participating in this test.

AP Test information: This is a gentle reminder that the window to order AP tests is now open. Sign up sheets are available in the counseling office. Once complete, have your child take the completed form along with payment directly to the ASB office either before school, during brunch or lunch to get registered. We only offer tests for classes taught on our SHS campus. The last day to order any AP test will be February 28th. Sign up early as space is limited for some tests.
